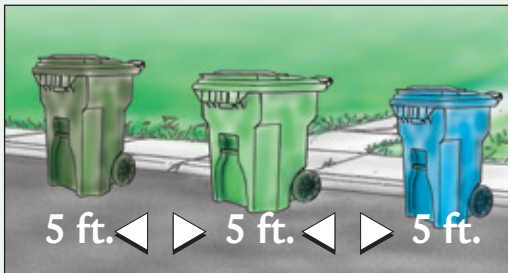


Cart Placement

To make the collection process easier and safer, we appreciate your cooperation to place carts as below.

- Place cart at the street the night before collection
- Place your cart 4 to 5 feet away from other carts, poles, mailboxes and 10 feet from vehicles if possible
- Place handles toward the house so the cart opens toward the street
- Keep carts out of bike lanes if possible

PLEASE DO NOT PUT YOUR YARD DEBRIS IN PLASTIC BAGS

Do NOT Put These Items In The Cart

“Items To Avoid”

- NO Plastic Bags
- NO Bark, Dirt or Sod
- NO Rocks or Gravel
- NO Animal Waste
- NO Stumps or Logs
- NO Ashes
- NO Metals
- NO Rubber
- NO Plastic Pots
- NO Food Items
- NO Trash of ANY Kind

Material inside the yard debris cart SHOULD NOT stick out. The lid must be able to shut and lie flat.



What To Put In The Cart!

Generally speaking: “If It Grows It Goes”

- Plant prunings
- Leaves
- Weeds
- Grass Clippings
- Brush & woody materials up to 2” diameter
(be sure the lid lies flat)
